

H1N1 Virus Pandemic Planning Survey

Thank you to all our members who took part in our survey, the aim of which was to gauge our member's level of concerns and business preparedness should the H1N1 Virus affect the number of New Zealanders that were forecast. Given that the retail sector employs some 17% of the New Zealand labour force, and interacts with many customers on a daily basis, this puts the front-line service staff at considerably more risk to exposure of any virus. You will note from the results below that there are a large number of members who responded to our survey as either being reasonably prepared or not prepared at all. We strongly encourage our members to plan ahead to mitigate impacts on their business brought about by any manner of events – illness being just one.
